Submission Dates: We will receive submissions from May 1, 2020 through October 1, 2020.

Applicants chosen to participate will be notified by October 9, 2020.

All selected participants must confirm their participation by October 16, 2020.

Georgia NATS active members in good standing and students of GA NATS active members are invited to submit proposals for a poster session to be presented at the 2020 Georgia NATS Student Auditions. Proposed poster presentations topics below are suggested to appeal to both STUDENTS and TEACHERS. Proposals will be selected by the Georgia NATS Proposal Review Committee. Dr. May will collect and distribute all materials to the committee members for review and selection of participants.

They will be required to provide their own materials (handouts, poster, stands, etc.) and will be responsible for any travel and lodging, as needed. A table will be provided on-site for your poster display. The following items below will be required as part of the application process. Submission materials must include the two attached pdf documents via e-mail:

- A PDF document narrative of your proposal that must NOT contain any identifying information as proposals will be reviewed through a blind review process (2 page maximum)
- A PDF document that contains the following information for preparation on our webpage, schedule of events, and presentation information for selected participants
 - Poster Presentation Title & Abstract (maximum of 150 words)
 - Presenter Name
 - Name and e-mail of one active NATS member we may contact who may verify your expertise in the area you are proposing.
 - Employer/University/College/Studio/ or Faculty Advisor if submitting as a student
 - Email
 - Phone Contact
 - Mailing Address
 - Presenter Bio (maximum of 150 words)
 - Headshot
